

# Portfolio Project

---

## Part I – getting ready

1. Create a new folder LastnamePortfolio (not spaces)
2. Drag the following project folders into your new portfolio folder (rename your folders so they have no spaces)
3. Important! -Check your sites do they still work? Be sure you copied all images as well as html files. Don't go on until your sites work!

Projects you need to copy:

- a. HTML Animal Site
  - b. HTML Business Site
  - c. Wiki (or Internet Definitions)
4. In Fireworks create a button – named Animals (or the name of your animal site) (save to portfolio folder)
  5. In Fireworks create a button - for your business site (save to portfolio folder)
  6. In Fireworks create a button for your wiki site

## Part II – creating your portfolio page

1. Create a new html page save it as index.html
2. Add your new header graphic you made yesterday
3. Add the buttons you made for links to your sites
4. Link your buttons to your pages
  - a. Hint – you have to know the name of your home page – take note it is case sensitive
  - b. You also have to include the folder name for example

```
<a href=HTMLANIMAL/index.html> <img src=animalbutton.png></a>
```

5. HTML Animal is the name of the folder that has your home page for the animal website.
6. Link the wiki button to your wiki page – go to my home page – click on the pbwiki link, click on your page – then copy the url address
7. Go back to you html document and link your button use the following code: (hint paste the http: address in that you copied)

```
< a href=http://www.pbwiki.com/yourname></a>
```
